6. The organisers and owners of Checkendon Equestrian Centre accept no responsibility for any damages, loss or accident, injury to horses, owners, riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.
7. Please use the bins provided for all litter.
8. Competitors making telephone or email entries will be expected to pay their entry fee whether or not they compete.
9. Closing date is one week before competition.
10. Late entries received after the closing date will carry the extra charge of £3
11. No smoking.
12. Consent is given for results to be published in public domain
